QUEEN SCHOLARSHIP RULES

1. The winner of the Johnson County Pioneers and Old Settlers Reunion Association Scholarship must submit, to the chairman of the Scholarship Committee, a written statement describing the education or training she wishes to pursue and the school she has chosen. This statement must be submitted within three months after the date of graduation** and must be approved by the scholarship committee of the Johnson County Pioneers and Old Settlers Reunion Association. Upon receiving this statement of intent and a letter from the college or university informing the committee of your enrollment, the scholarship will be expended as explained below.
2. The scholarship shall be claimed and expended only for tuition, room, board, books, school fees and supplies.
3. Use of the scholarship must begin within six months from the date of graduation from high school**.
4. One half of the scholarship will be awarded the first semester, and the remaining one half will be awarded the second semester, unless otherwise approved by the committee.
5. In the event that the education or training is not completed or not in consecutive semesters, the balance of the scholarship will be canceled.
6. Any canceled or unused portion of the scholarship will revert back to the Johnson County Pioneers and Old Settlers Reunion Association Scholarship Fund.
7. Scholarship winners must submit to the Johnson County Pioneers and Old Settlers Reunion Association Scholarship Committee a written progress report of her educational activities at least semi-annually. If a period of twelve months elapses without such acknowledgment, the balance of the scholarship will be automatically canceled.
8. A scholarship winner who does not wish to avail herself of the educational opportunities will forfeit the scholarship.
9. All bills and correspondence pertaining to the Johnson County Pioneers and Old Settlers Reunion Association Scholarship Fund should be directed to:

10. The scholarship must be utilized in the state of Texas.

**If current year chosen Queen has already graduated from high school, and is CURRENTLY enrolled in college then this statement, plus college enrollment information must be submitted as soon as possible for the current semester, or no later than the 3 months after the contest for the semester beginning in January. Scholarship will be available for two consecutive semesters whether Queen chooses to start with current semester, or the next semester beginning after the current annual event.
